Radio Magazine Awards TFT NAB2004 Pick Hit

Las Vegas, Nevada – April 21, 2004 – *Radio* magazine has recognized TFT's 6-Channel UNcompressed Digital STL System with a Pick Hit Award at NAB2004. The Pick Hit Awards, created in 1985 and celebrating their 20th year, go to the 15 best new radio products shown at NAB. They are considered to be the highest technical honor awarded at the annual NAB convention.



An independent panel of radio industry professionals selects the products as Pick Hits because they have a positive impact on the intended user's everyday work and provide new solutions to common problems. These judges remain anonymous to everyone until a selection meeting is held. The Pick Hits offer substantial improvement over previous technology and often involve some new approach or application in their design.

The TFT 460/467 is the broadcast industry's first 6-channel UNcompressed Digital STL. Both the transmitter and receiver are PC configurable and use 256/64/16QAM modulation at sampling rates of 48, 44.1, and 32 ks/s. Input and output rate converters are included, and the I/Os can be either AES/EBU or analog for all 6 channels. A 9600 baud data channel is included standard. The units are frequency agile in 3.125 kHz steps and occupy a single 500 kHz channel. (FCC Part 74 Type Notification is required for sale in the U.S.A. and is pending.)

TFT, headquartered in San Jose, California, has been manufacturing monitoring, STL, and EAS equipment for the broadcast industry since 1970 and is proud to have been honored by *Radio* and its publisher.
